



Quality matters, starts at home...




Separate collection obligations to

- → Prevent cross-contamination of recyclables (metals, paper, glass, plastics, e-waste, bio-waste, textile...) & preserve quality
- → Minimize the amount of residual waste



...And throughout the value chain



EN 643 agreed with the paper industry setting quality standards for **recovered paper** grades



...But has yet to be valued by EU legislation

- 1. Different status of the recovered paper inside the EU.
- 2. Different enforcement of the WSR inside the EU hampering a well-functioning internal market for paper




Briding recycling & end-markets World wide recovered paper market

Average price evolution for recovered paper








From proper collection to end-markets – How to close the loop

PROMOTE **RECYCLING** SAVES PRIMARY RESOURCES, ENERGY & CO₂

Promote design for circularity by any means available (e.g. modulate fees based on products' recyclability & recycled content)

Boost demand for recycled materials by supporting capacity building for industries using SRM Reward recycling CO2 & energy savings (GPP, incentives) throughout the value chain

Value quality and ensure a wellfunctioning internal market for recycling through end-of-waste criteria based on quality standards/industry specs Reward recycling CO2 & energy savings (GPP,
