Paper and packaging waste



Initial Challenge – long history

- Packaging waste: Paper & Cardboard (P&C), Glass & Metal (G&M), Plastic
- From the budget 1995: "The waste agency should work for waste reduction and recycling" and "The Oslo model should be introduced in Oslo south" (door to door collection of P&C). Roll out finished in 1998
- Oslo's door to door collection went from one bin with all kind of waste to a "two bin system"
 - Bin 1 residual waste. Waste fee depends on bin size of residual waste
 - Bin 2 (P&C) is free of charge
- Budget targets in 2006 for G&M. "90% of households should have less then 300 meters to a recycling point (rp) in 2009". 2006 462rp /2009-616rp/2018–1022rp
- In 2009 started door to door collection of Plastic packaging and Food waste. Roll out finished in 2012.
- Oslo continued with the "two bin system" in addition to a increasing number of recycling stations (11 small and 4 large)
